

Test Taking Tips

Read all parts of the directions and read them twice.

Ask questions if you don't understand.

Budget your time. Don't get stuck on one question.

Skip the question if you don't know the answer and come back to it later.

Read the question first.

Read all the answer choices before you choose one.

Use the process of elimination. A 50/50 chance is better than 1 in 4.

Don't change an answer unless you are certain your second answer is correct.

Use context for unknown words.

If you have time, check your answers.

As a last resort, guess if it doesn't hurt your score.
