If over 21 years old header on card is green and picture on the right. If under 21 header is red and picture is on left. Why get an Ohio ID Card? Use to prove your identity, i.e. cashing checks and using credit card, flying on commercial airlines. Getting an Ohio ID card: Department of Motor Vehicles or deputy registrar office— see listing for your city in Ohio. Cost is \$8.50 Need primary and secondary documents, residency documents, and US legal presence documents- Reference: www.bmv.ohio.gov/acceptable-id-documents.stm Review each set of documents and emphasize the following: Must provide proof of name, date of birth. Social Security number must be on at least one document. Documents must be original.
