Materials	Ohio recommended vaccine schedule (Check local Board of Health on the Internet). County map (Internet)
Activities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In small groups, the students will remember and discuss vaccines they received in their home countries. One person from each group will share out about what another person said. 2. Students will receive a copy of the vaccine schedule from the Internet. They will go through and mark which ones they have received. They can do the same for their family members if they wish. 3. Teacher will provide the address for the closest health department vaccine clinic (from Internet). Students will use a county map to locate the clinic in relation to their home address.
Assessment/ Evidence	Each student will write a list of vaccines they are missing. Then, they will write step-by-step driving or public transportation directions of how to arrive at the vaccine clinic. (Directions would have been

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	covered in previous lessons).
Reflection	<p>In their homes, students will locate vaccine records for themselves and family members. They will compare the records with the schedule of recommended vaccines and make a plan to catch up on any missing vaccines.</p>
