Activities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Ask the class as a group if their family celebrates Halloween or not. Have various class members share out if they do or not and how they celebrate. 2) Provide the class with the date and time of this year's Trick-or-Treat night. In small groups, have the students generate a list of what they should expect to see, hear, and do that evening in their neighborhoods. 3) Distribute the list of safety tips from the website above. The students will review their lists and highlight the items where there may be danger where caution must be practiced.
Assessment/Evidence	Students will write a plan of what they and their family will do on Trick-or-Treat night (whether they go outside the home to celebrate or not).
Reflection	Students will take their plan and safety tips home and discuss with their family what actions to take in the event of danger on Trick-or-Treat night.
