Materials	Chart on WWII, worksheet on United Nations, timeline info gap for intermediate group, flash cards for higher level group, questions for N-400 for higher level, crayons or colored pencils
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Say the Pledge together – pronunciation practice • Introduce topic – The 20th Century – using timeline to review history so far • Divide into reading groups: Ask students to define 20th century. Write up World War II and ask students to talk to a partner about what they know about the war. Share ideas with group. Teacher clarifies concepts if needed. Give out chart on “Allies and Axis” – help students fill out the chart. Give out world map. Have students color the Allies countries in one color and the Axis in another. • United Nations – explain that after the War, the United Nations was started. Ask class what the words mean. What do they think UN does? Work with students to fill out the worksheet. Have students circle what UN does. • Spelling test and dictation sentences
